MASTER IN PUBLIC HEALTH (MPH)

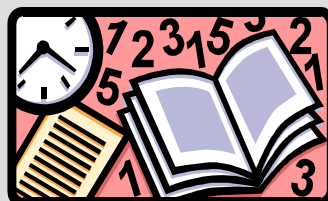


MPH Programme

The Master of Public Health (MPH), a one-year degree program at CHPS is being run through Al-Khair University affiliation. Al Khair is the 3rd oldest private university of Pakistan and recognized by the Higher Education Commission (HEC). The MPH program is being conducted on a semester system.

SCOPE

MPH enables candidates to be placed in different development agencies of the world i.e nationally and internationally. MPH degree holders can hope to be placed in NGOs, Local Health Depts., Population Depts., and Donor Agencies etc.



ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY

MPH is for a variety of development workers (please see the list below) and not just for medical doctors or people belonging to the medical profession. The candidates are selected on merit as determined by candidates' previous academic standings. Basic requirement for admission to MPH programme is that the candidate has obtained.

- a) MBBS/BDS degree or its equivalent from a recognized university.
- OR**
- b) Master's degree in nursing, social sciences, life sciences and humanities from a recognized university. These include the subjects of Biochemistry, Microbiology, Botany, Zoology, Physiology, Anatomy, Chemistry, Physics, Pharmacy, Psychology, Sociology, Home Economics, Social Work, Nutrition, Business Administration, Computer Science and Public Administration.
